Contestants will compete in the following events. All scoring and age divisions will be conducted the same way as any other Cinderella Preliminary Pageant.

Photogenic: Please upload one picture (typically head and shoulders) that shows the photogenic qualities of your child. Judges will base their scores on the quality of the photo, the personality shown and the overall impression.

Interview: iCinderella interviews will be conducted in a private interview setting, where participants ages 3-29 years should wear simple, tailored dresses. Interview questions that are age appropriate will be sent to the participant's chaperone. This phase of competition is designed for the judges to get to know the contestants a little better and to get to see them in a more relaxed setting. Baby Participants do not compete in this phase of the competition.

Party Wear Modeling: Contestants will model in their formal wear (street length, Easter type dresses for ages 0-12; full-length formals for 13 and up). Contestants will follow the traditional Cinderella Modeling Pattern. Baby Participants do not follow the Cinderella Modeling Pattern. They will model with a chaperone. The Cinderella modeling music and instructions will be emailed to you upon receipt of your pageant entry and payment. See more rules below.

Casual Wear Modeling: For young ladies ages 3-29 only. The wardrobe expected is casual outfits, pants, dresses, shorts, and skirts are all appropriate (contestants do not generally wear jeans, and no hats or props allowed). Contestants will follow the traditional Cinderella Modeling Pattern and will introduce on the second "X" by stating their name, age and the city in which they live. The Cinderella modeling music and instructions will be emailed to you upon receipt of your pageant entry and payment. Baby Participants do not compete in this phase of the competition, but they will participate in this event at State.

Talent/Tot Personality: Young ladies ages 7-29 are required to compete in Talent competition. They may sing, dance, cheer, tumble, read a poem, play an instrument, etc. Time limit is 2 minutes and 30 seconds, no exceptions. Tots (girls 3-6) do not compete in talent, but instead do a short on-stage one-on-one interview with the emcee, called "Tot Personality". For all iCinderella Pageants, there is no need for an additional interview segment. The judges will use the score from the original interview for Tot Personality. Baby Participants do not compete in this phase of the competition.

AWARDS

Overall Winner: Judged on all phases of competition. One overall winner in each age group will receive: Official crown, trophy, banner and official qualification and invitation to the Florida Cinderella State Pageant.

Beauty: Judged on combined score for interview and modeling events. One winner in each age group will receive: Official crown, trophy, banner and official qualification and invitation to the Florida Cinderella State Pageant.

Talent/Personality: Judged on the Talent and Tot Personality/Tot Interview phase of the competition. One winner in each age group will receive: Official crown, trophy, banner and official qualification and invitation to the Florida Cinderella State Pageant.

Photogenic Winner: Judged on photo only. One winner in each age group will receive: Official crown, trophy, banner and official qualification and invitation to the Florida Cinderella State Pageant.

"HONOR ROLL" OPTION:

All of the Honor Roll contestants that have either already participated in a 2021 preliminary pageant or are from other states are welcome and encouraged to enter this pageant for the sake of practice and judges' and State Directors comments. Honor Roll contestants are not eligible for awards but will receive recognition of their participation during the LIVE Awards announcement.

PAGEANT RULES

- The deadline to submit Entry Forms and payment is Wednesday, May 5th.
- The deadline to submit Videos is Thursday, May 6th.
- All judging will be conducted on Friday morning, May 7th by 3 separate judges using a ballot system.
- Winners will be announced LIVE on the Florida Cinderella Facebook Page, Friday, May 7th.
- All videos will become the property of Florida Cinderella and will not be shown publicly, but portions could be used for advertising purposes.
- Awards can either be shipped to the winner for a shipping fee, or can be provided at the State Pageant.
- Judges critiques and Directors critiques will be sent within one week of the pageant. Critiques should be used constructively and as a way to help prepare the participant for the State pageant. Scoresheets will not be shared with any participant.

VIDEO GUIDELINES

- ALL videos must be shot HORIZONTAL, no exceptions. Recordings can be done on cell phone. The participant will NOT be judged on quality of video.
- Use bright lighting.
 - Do NOT stand with a window directly behind you.
 - Do NOT use harsh overhead lighting as it will create a shadow on the contestant's face.
 - DO make sure lighting is not dark (aka filmed with no lights on in the dark).
 - DO stand with the window facing contestant (so the natural light is hitting their face).
- Please make sure sound quality is good.
 - Do NOT have tv, radio or people making noise in background.
 - DO make sure contestant speaks loud and clear.
 - When the music is being used, make sure it is NOT louder than the contestant speaking.

TALENT VIDEO

- Make sure the entire contestant is shown in video from head to toe. Do not cut off part of participant.
- As we know, space is limited! You can film outside or inside.
- A video from a former performance can be used, but it must be within this current staging year and CANNOT be from another "in person" pageant.

PARTY WEAR/CASUAL WEAR VIDEO

- Cinderella music and modeling guidelines are still in effect for all phases. Once we receive your entry form and fee, we will send you the Cinderella Modeling Instruction Sheet as well as your own copy of our modeling music via email.
- Make sure FULL contestant is being shown in video.
- Use space available to you. The participant will not be penalized for a small modeling area. X's can be used to mark your staging area to help guide the participant.

INTERVIEW/TOT PERSONALITY VIDEO

- A list of age appropriate interview questions will be sent to you once we receive your entry form and fee.
- Interviews will be conducted by the participant's chaperone.
- Interview must NOT be longer than 2 minutes and 30 seconds.
- Please set up a chair for the contestant to sit in during interview.
- Make sure the contestant is loud and clearly heard in video.
- For Tot Personality, the Tot interviews will be used. No need to send in two interview segments.

HOW AND WHERE TO UPLOAD YOUR VIDEO

A DropBox link will be sent to you via email when we receive your Entry Form and fee. If you do not have a DropBox account, you can register for one for free via their website and their 30 day free trial offer. Please upload all videos to the folder as SEPARATE files. Be sure to include the contestant's name on each file. Do NOT send YouTube links! All Videos MUST be received no later than Friday, November 13th by midnight, NO EXCEPTIONS!!
